10th pass plus National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT OR 10th pass plus ITI.

- For all other departments of the Railways, the minimum educational qualification will continue to be the same as mentioned in para-1 above.
- 4. Cases already under process will continue to be dealt in terms of earlier instructions.

As more and more girls remain in school, it is envisaged that they will use the opportunity to gain skills and knowledge that will help them become economically independent. Even if girls do get married soon after they turn 18, it is expected that their education and enhanced social and emotional development will give them a better foundation for their adult lives. And over time, as entire generations of women enter marriages only after they have some degree of economic independence, it is expected that the practice of child marriage is completely eradicated, and women will attain their right to health, education and socioeconomic equality.
